

Opening Prayer:

God is a speaking God, and He speaks to His children every day. We have the wonderful opportunity to listen to Him and learn to hear His voice. We don't have to go through life blindly making decisions or relying on our own abilities. We can hear Him clearly and consistently.

We can hear God's voice every day and walk in the confidence of being led by the Spirit in your life. Here is a prayer to hear God's voice we can pray in faith:

Your Word says Your sheep know Your voice and we will not follow the voice of a stranger. Help us to know Your voice and not be deceived by any other voice. Help us to guard our hearts from the influences of this world and the people around us. Help us not to be deceived by the devil and his lies, but to view all thoughts and decisions through the lens of righteousness.

Prayers for offerings and intercession

Oh, Lord, you shepherd us. You follow us. You lead us through the fog of our times. We get caught up in fear and weighed down by seemingly eternal prejudices.

Open our minds to the alarming calamity of war, its evil nature that sets and divides and drains. Shake loose our compassion. Help us to understand the power of bearing witness in these times, with the wars in Ukraine, Israel/Palestine, South Sudan, and Syria devastating those nations and their peoples.

We know war in one place affects us all. We ask that leaders find a way for international disarmament treaties to be renewed. Help us to understand that Russia needs help to transition to climate-friendly energy industries as well as Europe, the U.S. and China. War is not green; it is grey, bloody, and cold.

We witness the natural disasters compounded by social and political upheaval. It becomes crisis within crisis within crisis. We mourn for the peoples of Syria and Turkey, as they deal with the terrible aftermath of the earthquakes there.

Wake us up to the wanton neglect of our role, our covenant, as neighbours and as stewards on this planet. We hear of the 2 million refugees from Ukraine now in Poland, of the 1 million taken in by Germany.

Help us to see our neighbour: the one parking their car next to us in the shopping mall; a classroom acquaintance we have never really given a "hello"; a tentative visitor at our church; the the homeless man at the corner; a friend known to us grieving the loss of a loved one; families struggling to pay bills; a father or mother struggling to put food on the table; a neighbour in need of someone to talk to; a family, individual or community who, for various reasons, have lost hope and need a reason to live on, to believe, to smile or even to meet with Christ and receive the joy He gives.

May we hear your voice sending us our model Christ in the places where we live, worship or work. May we point people to you, help them to know you, to hear your voice and to make you known. Use us, speak to us,

Speak a prophet word through us. Let us stand in "the Christ-centred bond of our common humanity" and in the voice from Psalm 130 sing, shout, softly whisper: "Let everything that breathes praise the Lord!" Amen
