





On the road to Emmaus




Glorious God of all,

Another Easter Prayer By Michael Youngson



We pray that the Easter light of life, hope and joy, will live in us each day; and that we will be bearers of that light into the lives of others. Amen.


Our Father, which art in heaven,

Lord, give healing, give comfort, give perseverance.





We lift all of these things to You now Offering the prayers of our own hearts; trusting them to You now in a moment of quietness [PAUSE for silent prayer]


In all our prayers, we pray trusting in Your sure and certain promise, through Jesus Christ our Lord, Amen
